¹ Defra does not publish data on how much feed is used on UK fish farms. I asked where I could find this data and was told they do not publish data on the amounts of feed produced by individual companies. Based on a previous battle in relation to obtaining data on how much of particular antibiotic was used, which took a strong public interest case, 3 years of correspondence and determined help from the information commissioner to win, my understanding is that this means there are only one or two major manufacturers of fish feed in the UK and Defra doesn't release the total data as rival companies could then calculate how much was being produced by their commercial competitors.
