

Timings and Security

Everyone attending on the 10th will need to bring a form of PHOTO ID with them to pass through security.

If you are attending on Monday 10th, for security reasons you will need to have passed through registration by 9:00am.

Registration will open at 8am, so I would encourage you to arrive as early as possible to make sure you register and go through for tea and coffee in good time. If you do not arrive before 9:15am (at the very latest), you will unfortunately not be allowed entry to the opening plenary session.

Directions

Conference address - Llandovery College, Llandovery, Carmarthenshire, SA20 0EE

From London/Bristol - The best way to get to Llandovery is to take the M4 over the Severn Bridge, coming off at junction 24 onto the A449. At Raglan, take the exit on the A40 towards Abergavenny, then follow this road all the way, through Crickhowell and past Brecon until you reach Llandovery.

From Cardiff - From Cardiff town centre take the A470 towards PontyPridd and continue for 34.7 miles past Merthyr Tydfil until you reach a left hand turning onto the A4215. Follow the signs to Sennybridge, then join the A40 towards Llandovery.

PLEASE NOTE - there is very limited phone/GPS reception in the Llandovery area, so make sure to set your sat-nav well in advance of driving into deep Wales (speaking from personal experience!)

Parking

There are three main car parking options during the conference

- 1) The College prep-school car park (see map of the College ground attached below) has 70 spaces available, but these will no doubt fill up quite quickly.
- 2) Llandovery Town Council pay and display car park (turn left at the Castle Hotel) - £1.50 for the day.
- 3) The Livestock Market car park. We have hired this space specifically for the event and it has plentiful spaces available. However, it does have to be locked between the hours of 10:00pm - 8:00am. Cars can be left in here overnight, but please be aware that if you need to leave within these hours, you will need to

move your car into the pay and display car park which is free during these night-time hours.
